| 1) Burial Of Jesus (Friday) | 27:57-61 | 15:42-47 | 23:50-56 | 19:38-42 |

- **John 19: Joseph & Nicodemus (Jewish leaders)**
 - Jewish leaders & secret disciples
 - 75 lbs of spice (royal amount)
- **Mat 27:58 – Joseph asked Pilate for Jesus' body**
- **Mat 27:61 – Mary Magdalene & other Mary sitting opposite tomb**

Events After the Cross

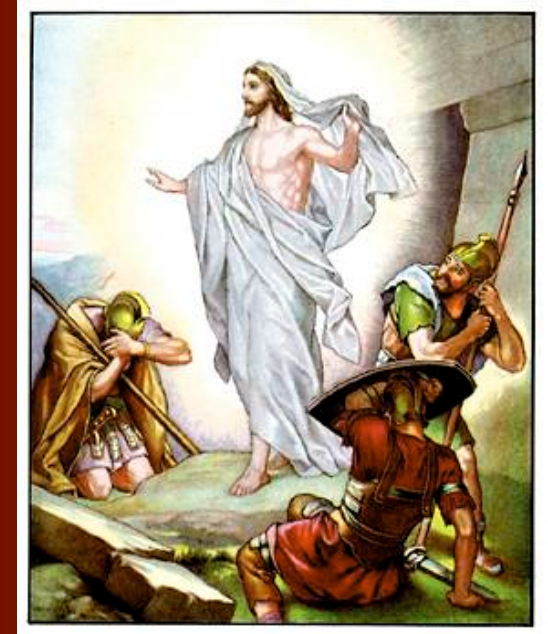

| 2) Guards Posted at Tomb (Saturday) | 27:62-66 | | | |

- **Mat 27: 62**The next day, the one after Preparation Day, the chief priests and the Pharisees went to Pilate. **63**"Sir," they said, "**we remember that while he was still alive that deceiver said, 'After three days I will rise again.'** **64**So give the order for the tomb to be made secure until the third day. Otherwise, his disciples may come and steal the body and tell the people that he has been raised from the dead. This last deception will be worse than the first." **65**"Take a guard," **Pilate answered. "Go, make the tomb as secure as you know how."** **66**So they went and made the tomb secure by putting a seal on the stone and posting the guard.

|------------------------|--------|--------|------|------|
| 3) Earthquake (Sunday) | 28:1-4 | 16:1-3 | | |

- **Mark 16:1** – Mary Magdelene & Mary, mother of James.
- **Mark 16:3** “Who will roll the stone away from entrance of tomb”?
- **Mat 28:2** - Earthquake and angel rolled away the stone
- **Mat 28:4** - 4The **guards** were so afraid of him that they shook and became like dead men.



Events After the Cross

| 4) Empty Tomb & Peter | | 16:4-8 | 24:1-12 | 20:1-10 |

- **Luke 24:6-8**

- 6He is not here; he has risen! Remember how he told you, while he was still with you in Galilee: 7'The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, be crucified and on the third day be raised again.' " **8Then they remembered his words.**

- **Mk 16:7** — 7But go, tell his disciples and Peter, 'He is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him, just as he told you.' "

- **John 20:3** 3So Peter and the other disciple started for the tomb.

- **John 20:10** 10Then the disciples went back to their homes

Events After the Cross

|------------------------------------|---------|---------|------|----------|
| 5) Jesus Appears to Mary (& Women) | 28:5-10 | 16:9-11 | | 20:11-18 |

- **John 20:11-18**

- 17 Jesus said, "Do not hold on to me, for I have not yet returned to the Father. Go instead to my brothers and tell them, 'I am returning to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.' "

- 18 Mary Magdalene went to the disciples with the news: "I have seen the Lord!" And she told them that he had said these things to her.

- **Mk 16:11 –When they heard that Jesus was alive and that she had seen him, they did not believe it.**

| 6) Bribing of the guards | 28:11-15 | | | |

- **Mat 28 – 11** While the women were on their way, some of the guards went into the city and reported to the chief priests everything that had happened. **12** When the chief priests had met with the elders and devised a plan, they gave the soldiers a large sum of money, **13** telling them, "You are to say, 'His disciples came during the night and stole him away while we were asleep.'"

Events After the Cross

|--|------|----------|----------|------|
| 7) Jesus Appears to 2 (on Road to Emmaus) | | 16:12-13 | 24:13-35 | |

- **Luke 24:13-34**

- 13 Now that same day two of them were going to a village

- called Emmaus, about seven miles [a] from Jerusalem.

- 18 One of them, named Cleopas, (husband of other Mary – John 19:25)

- 32 They asked each other, "**Were not our hearts burning within us while he talked with us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us?**"

- 33 They got up and returned at once to Jerusalem.

- **Mark 16:12-13** 12 Afterward Jesus appeared in a different form to two of them while they were walking in the country.

- 13 These returned and reported it to the rest; **but they did not believe them either.**

| 8) Jesus Appears to the 10 Disciples | | | 24:36-43 | 20:19-23 |
| 9) Jesus Appears to 11 (including Thomas) | | 16:14 | | 20:24-31 |

- **John 20:27-29**

27 Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe."

28 Thomas said to him, "My Lord and my God!"

29 Then Jesus told him, "Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."

- **We have been too hard on Thomas**

Events After the Cross

| Events | Matt | Mark | Luke | John |
|------------------------|------|------|------|---------|
| 10) Jesus Appears to 7 | | | | 21:1-14 |

- **3rd appearance to disciples (7 of them)**
- **Simon – back to fishing**
- **Didn't catch anything all night**
- **Throw to the right**
- **153 fish**
- **Peter jumped into water (100 yards out)**
- **Reminder of their purpose!!!!**

Conclusion of the Gospels

- **John 21 – Restore Peter and gave him back his purpose.**
- **Mat 28:16-20 – Great commission**
- **Luke 24:45-53 – 51While he was blessing them, he left them and was taken up into heaven. 52Then they worshiped him and returned to Jerusalem with great joy. 53And they stayed continually at the temple, praising God.**
- **Mark 16**
 - **19After the Lord Jesus had spoken to them, he was taken up into heaven and he sat at the right hand of God. 20Then the disciples went out and preached everywhere, and the Lord worked with them and confirmed his word by the signs that accompanied it.**
